**RULES/EXPECTATIONS/CONSEQUENCES.**

Respect, order, and discipline in the classroom are necessary to provide an effective learning environment. Parents please read and discuss our rules, expectations and consequences with your student.

**EXPECTATIONS**

1. Students should attend every class.
2. Students should arrive 5-10 minutes before class starts.
3. Students should come to class prepared and bring all appropriate materials.
4. Students are expected to participate in all class activities.
5. Students should follow the directions of the teacher and the room parent/helper.
6. Students and parents are encouraged to participate in all programs, celebrations and cultural events of our Greek School throughout the year.
7. Students and parents are encouraged to practice using the Greek language as much as possible.

**CLASSROOM RULES**

1. Students should remain seated during class, be attentive, and work quietly.
2. Students should raise their hand to be recognized.
3. Students should listen when the teacher or another student is talking.
4. Students should keep hands, feet, and objects to themselves to allow others to work undisturbed.

5. Students should use appropriate language. There should be no yelling, whistling, teasing, name calling, threats, obscene language, etc.
6. Students should not bring toys or cell phones to class.
7. Students should not leave the classroom without permission.
8. Students should respect school property and the property of others.
9. Students should not damage or destroy anything in the classroom/building.
10. Students should walk in an orderly fashion while in the classroom or halls.
11. Students should line up inside the classroom to be picked up after class dismissal.
12. Students should not take home anything that belongs to the school unless they have permission from the teacher.

## **CONSEQUENCES OF SCHOOL RULE VIOLATIONS**

1. Verbal warning. Name on whiteboard.
2. Second warning. Checkmark placed beside name on the board.
3. Circle name on board. Removal from class. Time out. Student can join the class again when ready to participate in a positive way. Room Parent contacts parents.
4. Parent/student meeting with Principal/Teacher if inappropriate behavior continues.
5. In case of damages, the person responsible should replace or pay.
